Labibi is a base package to use for documentation and Web sites for other projects of mine.

For now, I've made it fairly easy to post sites to [ReadTheDocs](#) that enable Google Analytics, Disqus commenting, and easy source file editing. You can check it out at the [labibi demo site](#).

This is directly based off of Mikko Ohtamaa's excellent work on [the Plone documentation](#).

A brief HOWTO do this for your own ReadTheDocs site:

0. [Get started with ReadTheDocs](#).
1. Create a `_static/` directory and put [labibi.css](#) and [labibi.js](#) in it.
2. Put `"html_style = 'labibi.css'"` in your `conf.py`
3. Create a `_templates/` directory and put [page.html](#) in there.
4. Edit `'page.html'` to set your google analytics, disqus, and github info.

For now, you can't disable the editing functionality, but if you delete the `google_analytics` and `disqus_shortcode` it should disable that functionality on your site.
